



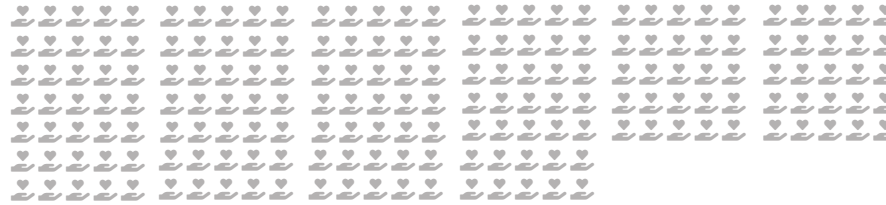

In 2025, Robins & Morton contributed more than

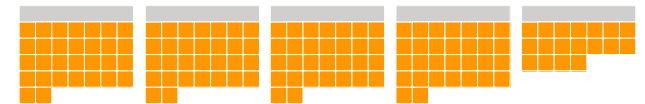
\$2.9 million

to charitable organizations, including **\$888,000** to community-related organizations and **\$1.97 million** for causes in partnership with clients and industry organizations.

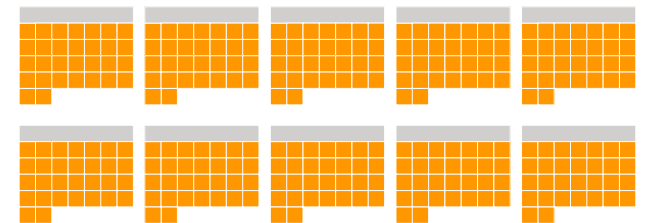
